Keith Season Report

The Keith year started with pre-season games against Ohoka at Mandeville, Diamond Harbour at Diamond Harbour and HSOB Second Grade at North Park, and our thanks go to all concerned for arranging those matches. This gave us a chance to blood some of the first batch of new boys and to see if any of the old hands had rusted up. With the services of **Robert Molloy** as referee for the second match, all three games were good measures of the season to come; both physical and spiritual.

The season proper started on the 8th April at Ilam 1 against one of the most consistent University sides, the Rockets.
